In 2018, Children's Law Center experienced record growth in the number of children represented in Minnesota courts. Every day, CLC staff members and volunteer lawyers worked with children who are in Minnesota's child protection system to ensure they had a voice in the legal proceedings that affect their daily lives. Because of partners like you, our child clients received the support and advocacy they deserve.

As our 2018 Community Report describes in greater detail, 929 youth clients received counsel from the CLC team. We thank the individuals, corporations, foundations, and law firms who supported CLC financially to provide the resources needed to keep representing

children in foster care. We are grateful for our long-term supporters, as well as our new funders, including the Pohlad Family Foundation, the F.R. Bigelow Foundation, the Saint Paul Foundation, and Cargill. 2018 was another year of growth for CLC. We represented 929 children and youth. This is an 11% increase since last year and a 150% increase since 2010. This steady increase in the past years is due to several factors: the changes made to Minnesota's child protection screening practices as a result of the 2015 Governor's Task Force on Protection of Children; opioid epidemic, which is now the number one reason why children are placed in foster care; and McKenna's Law, which now requires that all eligible children in foster care are immediately informed of their right to have an attorney. The most recent report from Minnesota's Department of Human Services further illustrates the growing number of youth in care when it found that there were 16,600 child and young adults in an out-of-home care in 2017.

We are very grateful to all our supporters for every contribution and grant made to help us sustain our growth. We are especially grateful to the Saint Paul and F.R. Bigelow foundations for funding a full-time attorney while CLC works on finding other resources to sustain our growth.

Our volunteer attorneys are the biggest gift CLC and our clients have. Their passion and dedication to this work is humbling and heartwarming. On average, each volunteer attorney spends 16-20 hours per client annually. Our volunteers advocate for our clients, they show up, they believe in them, and they amplify our child clients' voices in the courtroom when these voices aren't being heard.

I am also very grateful to our staff, the most humble colleagues I have ever worked with. It is a true privilege to be leading this passionate, hard working, mission driven team.

Together, with our donors and volunteers we continue to make a positive impact in the lives of Minnesota's most vulnerable population and invest in the future of our community. We thank each and every one of you for supporting us in 2018 and look forward to our continued partnership.


